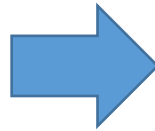

Calgary Chapter of AGNA Study Support

The format varies depending on the number of participants.

A) Small group (under 5 participants)

Mentorship by GNC Certified volunteers, led by the learning needs of the participants.

B) Large group (6 + participants)

This is an 8-week commitment. Participants receive weekly assignments to lead discussions on topics obtained from the Exam Blueprint and Specialty Competencies. Weekly meetings occur virtually, on Zoom.
